

"Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act" Notice

*Under federal banking regulations commercial customers must receive notice of the prohibition of conducting unlawful internet gambling transactions through banking systems. "Unlawful Internet gambling" is defined as placing, receiving, or otherwise knowingly transmitting a bet or wager by any means which involves the use, at least in part, of the Internet where such bet or wager is unlawful under any applicable Federal or State law in the State or Tribal lands in which the bet or wager is initiated, received, or otherwise made. Your account cannot be used for the payment or receipt of any gambling transactions which are unlawful.
